




Summer Report 2022

This summer featured some incredible new ways for people to experience Camp on the Boulder.

- There were six weeks of kids and student camps.

Throughout all Summer Camps across 10 grades we hosted **846 students** at Camp on the Boulder! Of those, **208 made a decision to follow Jesus** at camp.
